When I feel alone, who is my friend?

Fold arms horizontally across torso, hold out hands as if questioning Who wipes the tears from every eye,

Wipe both eyes on the beat

Who hears me when I pray at night, Oh Lord?

"Questioning hands," fold hands on pray

CHORUS:

Because You hold me in Your arms

Arms open, palms facing away, slowly hug yourself

I lift my hands to You

Lift hands (after vs. 2: "What else could I do?")

VERSE 2:

Who shall I fear? My Lord is with me

Biting nails, fists on hips, confidently nodding head "yes"

Where could I go where He's not there?

Hold out right, then left hand; shrug shoulders with "questioning hands"

You carry me through thick and thin

Catching punted football again

When I fall You bring me up again, Oh Lord!

Same as "trip and fall" and then go in reverse on "back again"

Clap to the beat, then shout w/hands around mouth



INTRO: Start out clapping to the beat, and clap in any musical interludes

VERSE 1:

There's a good sound rising from God's children now

Hold hand to ear on "sound," bring hands from waist up above head Because He sent His Son

Hands back down from over head on "sent"

Jesus came and set us free from dying

Point to nail prints in hand ASL for "Jesus," hold hands together as if tied, then break free on "free"

And so we clap our hands

Clap to the beat

CHORUS:

So clap your hands and stomp your feet

Clap to the beat, then stomp to the beat

We will not retreat

Thumbs to chest on "we," cross arms in front and shake head on "not," four fast claps w/recording

Jesus rises with our praise

Raise arms above head

And puts our enemies under our feet

Lower arms from above head, then four fast stomps like earlier claps

VERSE 2:

When God made the world so beautiful

Fists on top of each other like building, then make a circle w/fingers

The sons of God rejoiced

Dance freestyle

Jesus died to make us new again

Arms stretched out like a cross

And He forgave our sins

Cross fists in front, then break the X and spread hands and arms

REPEAT CHORUS

VERSE 3:

There's a new day comin' for His children now

Arms in front horizontally, raise top arm from horizontal to vertical. This is similar to ASL for "day."

A day with no more tears

Trace tears down your face, then wave them away to the side

Jesus will come and we will live with Him

ASL for "Jesus," lower arms for "come," hug yourself on "live with Him"

So clap your hands and stomp your feet

Clap to beat, then four fast stomps

REPEAT CHORUS

TAG:

Jesus died so we can live with Him

Arms stretched like cross, then hug yourself
So clap your hands and stomp your feet
Clap to beat, then four fast stomps

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

VERSE 1:

When I get older, I'm gonna learn piano Stroke invisible beard, mime piano playing on "piano" Or maybe a guitar, or maybe a banjo Strum air guitar, then pluck air banjo Or I might just clap the hands You gave me Clap hands to beat And stomp my feet and sing like crazy

Stomp to beat, then spin forefingers on sides of head for "crazy"

CHORUS:

But whatever I do, I'll do for You

Hands back and forth in front of body, point up w/both hands on "You" 'Cuz You made the sun, the stars and the moon

Move C-hand from head to sky for "sun," point up w/both forefingers back and forth for "stars," then move C-thumb and finger from head to skv for "moon"

You made my friends and family

Hook fingers together for "friends," then make "okay" signs with both hands with circles touching, then turn hands around backward for "family" (ASL)

And puppies and climbin' trees

Make puppy paws, then climb with puppy paws, and make a tree w/right arm and wiggle fingers on "trees"

And Jesus, You'll watch over me

Point to palms of hands for "Jesus," then hold one arm out and make other hand jump over arm for "over"

On land, in the sky, or on the sea

Palms down in front of body, make large circle parallel w/ground on "land," wave hand over head for "sky," make waves in front of body for "sea"

We'll be friends for eternity

Hug self and draw a circle above head with index finger

So in all I do, I give thanks to You

Hands back and forth in front of body, then point up w/both hands on "You"

VERSE 2:

When I get bigger, if I'm a banker

Hand on top of head, move up to show growth for "bigger," then hit back of right hand against palm of left and then stack papers for "banker"

Designer or doctor, or a homemaker

Move right pinky back and forth next to vertical left hand for "designer," feel pulse for "doctor," one fist on top of other like grinding grain for "homemaker" (ASL for "make")

I'll use the brains, the heart, the strength You gave me

Point to head, point to heart, flex biceps

To work real hard and serve like crazy

One fist on top of other like grinding grain for "work," spin forefingers on sides of head for "crazy"
