We appreciate the Keltys family!

- Our call volume has been low recently because of tax money coming out, but the volume is starting to increase again. When we're not busy it's a good thing because people are having their needs met.
- The biggest praise we have is that we were able to find a mattress o get a mother and her 2 children off the floor. We took her information and the very next call that we got was from Box Drop Mattress. They had a returned mattress that they couldn't resell it, so they either had to destroy it or donate it. It was a top-of-the-line pillow top California king-sized mattress. So, we did a pass-through donation. We have no warehouse space, so we can't normally take donations like that.
- We're looking to expand into "gap ministries." For example, First Church of the Nazarene has a diaper ministry that we use. We vet the clients, and they supply the diapers. Carpenter's Way has a medical ministry for medical supplies, etc. A couple of ideas that we have had are personal hygiene, linens, and shoes. Pray that we can identify churches to partner with us.
- And we always need volunteers! Contact us if you'd like to volunteer in our call center during the week.

1-4P Challenge

Find one unsaved person in your relational world and commit to the following:

P - Pray

Pray for this person. Pray for their salvation. Pray for opportunities and boldness to preach the gospel to them. See 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Colossians 4:2-4

P - Plan

Plan how you might engage them. This may include asking them to have coffee or inviting their family over for dinner. This may include inviting this individual to take 8 weeks to study the Bible with you. See Ephesians 5:15-16; Mark 6:7-12

P - Practice

Make sure you are practicing the gospel before them. This simply involves living a Christ-like life before them that validates the message of the gospel. Look for opportunities to serve them, encourage them, and show them kindness. See Colossians 4:5-6; Matthew 5:16

P - Proclaim

Finally, proclaim the gospel to them. This is the goal of evangelism. In fact, there is no evangelism without proclamation. Share with them the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus for sinners, and call them to repent and believe in Jesus for salvation from sin and the eternal wrath of God. See Romans 10:13-15
