Discussion Questions:

1. How does our passage answer the following three questions: (1) What should believers be doing? (2) Where (or with whom) should they be doing it? (3) And why?
2. How does thinking about the Triune God help us to gather with God's church more intentionally?
3. What does the writer of Hebrews mean when he says, "Let us consider how..." in vs. 24? Why is this important? In what way should this affect how you gather with the body on Sundays?
4. What does it mean to stir up one another to love and good works?
5. What does it mean to encourage one another, and why is this so important?
6. What is the reason for believers encouraging one another according to our passage?
7. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:3 and 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 together, and read 1 Thessalonians 5:23 and 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15 together. According to these passages, what's the relationship between sanctification (ongoing growth in holiness) and the church?
8. What effect might a church committed to doing the one-anothers together have on the world?

Application Questions:

1. How can we stir up one another to love and good works? How are you currently doing this? How can you grow here?
2. How can we encourage fellow church members? How are you currently doing this? How can you grow here?
3. How does thinking about the Lord's Return more affect your desire to be with the church?
4. What was your biggest takeaway from today's sermon?
5. How do you plan to apply what you learned from God's word today?
6. How can you prayerfully apply what you learned in today's passage?

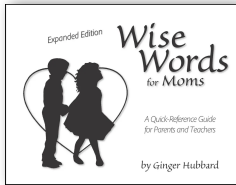

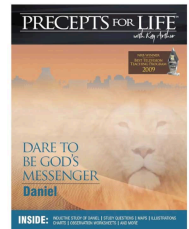


MOYA (Mother's of Young Arrows)

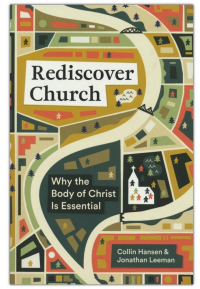

1-4P Challenge

Find one unsaved person in your relational world and commit to the following:

P - Pray

Pray for this person. Pray for their salvation. Pray for opportunities and boldness to preach the gospel to them. See 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Colossians 4:2-4

P - Plan

Plan how you might engage them. This may include asking them to have coffee or inviting their family over for dinner. This may include inviting this individual to take 8 weeks to study the Bible with you. See Ephesians 5:15-16; Mark 6:7-12

P - Practice

Make sure you are practicing the gospel before them. This simply involves living a Christ-like life before them that validates the message of the gospel. Look for opportunities to serve them, encourage them, and show them kindness. See Colossians 4:5-6; Matthew 5:16

P - Proclaim

Finally, proclaim the gospel to them. This is the goal of evangelism. In fact, there is no evangelism without proclamation. Share with them the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus for sinners, and call them to repent and believe in Jesus for salvation from sin and the eternal wrath of God. See Romans 10:13-15.
