MISSION PARTNER PRAYER FOCUS

Texas Baptist HOPE for Children (new name!)



- Pray for a first time foster family that took in a 1 & 3 yr old on Tuesday morning. There was obvious trauma for the 3 yr old.
- Pray for an 8 mo old who was suddenly returned to the birth parents and back into a situation of neglect. The foster parents are struggling and find themselves worrying about her.
- The summer months and long breaks can result in kids enduring abuse when school is out and people don't regularly have eyes on them. Please pray for the safety of Angelina County children.
- We are still actively seeking churches to allow TBHC to present the need for parents and/or host an interest meeting for potential foster parents.
- Pray for God to provide another staff member at our Lufkin office.
- Our Compassionate Hope International team just returned from Moldova where they were able to provide camp curriculum for 43 churches, conduct a trauma training for 48 CPS workers and 46 Kindergarten teachers as well as minister to 25 young ladies in transition homes.
- There are many changes going on here at TBHC, so prayers for God's will and encouragement for staff through these transitions would be greatly appreciated!
- Paula Havard, the Lufkin representative for TBHC, will be in the Fellowship Hall before & after services today to answer any questions you may have about the fostering process.

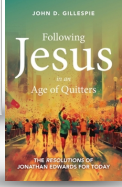
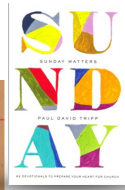
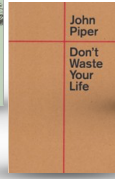

1-4P Challenge

Find one unsaved person in your relational world and commit to the following:

P - Pray

Pray for this person. Pray for their salvation. Pray for opportunities and boldness to preach the gospel to them. See 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Colossians 4:2-4

P - Plan

Plan how you might engage them. This may include asking them to have coffee or inviting their family over for dinner. This may include inviting this individual to take 8 weeks to study the Bible with you. See Ephesians 5:15-16; Mark 6:7-12

P - Practice

Make sure you are practicing the gospel before them. This simply involves living a Christ-like life before them that validates the message of the gospel. Look for opportunities to serve them, encourage them, and show them kindness. See Colossians 4:5-6; Matthew 5:16

P - Proclaim

Finally, proclaim the gospel to them. This is the goal of evangelism. In fact, there is no evangelism without proclamation. Share with them the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus for sinners, and call them to repent and believe in Jesus for salvation from sin and the eternal wrath of God. See Romans 10:13-15.
